Re: Pebble Project 2015 Application for Permits to Mine in Alaska and Plan of Operations

Ms. Bringhurst:

The Pebble Limited Partnership (PLP) is submitting the enclosed APMA for a Miscellaneous Land Use Permit (MLUP) governing activities on mining claims controlled by the Pebble East Claims Corporation and the Pebble West Claims Corporation. The subject claims are located on the north side of Iliamna Lake in the Lake and Peninsula Borough (USGS Topographic Maps Iliamna C7 & C8, D6, D7 & D8 Seward Meridian). Figures 3A – 3D in the enclosed application show the claim locations in Townships 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7S and Ranges 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, and 39W.

All previously disturbed areas, authorized by MLUP A13 6118, were reclaimed by the end of 2013. Likewise, all significant quantities of fuel were removed from the field in 2014. Field operations were largely consolidated to the main supply depot and three small satellite locations (West Bay 1, West Bay 3, and Watershed). PLP continues to operate a meteorological monitoring station (Pebble 1) and a radio repeater on Koptuli Mountain. Figure 4 in the enclosed application shows these locations. PLP staff routinely inspect these areas to ensure continued safe operation.

No additional land disturbing activities are planned for the Pebble Project at this time. The current Plan of Operations is limited to maintaining the main supply depot and satellite field locations through the end of 2016. Ground access to these locations will continue to be by helicopter only. PLP will submit an appropriate amendment to this application if our plans change to include any activity within the claim block that would require an approved reclamation plan or other state permit.

All permits should be issued in the name of Pebble East Claims Corporation, Pebble West Claims Corporation, and the Pebble Limited Partnership by its general partner, Pebble Mines Corp.
