Public Notice

The Shore Fishery Leasing Program within the Department of Natural Resources is evaluating shore fishery lease applications and amendments submitted during the 2019 application period. The public is welcome to review and comment on the proposed actions. Please follow the directions outlined at the end of this notice to submit any comments or protests. The Public Notice period begins **December 16, 2019**, and the deadline to submit written comments or protests is on or before **January 30, 2020**. Only those who submit timely written comments may appeal a decision.

Alaska Peninsula

Southeastern District

Robert M. Barnett, ADL 223662 (Amendment)

The proposed lease amendment is to add one net at 600 feet in length to his existing lease for a total of two nets each at 600 feet in length, located in the Shumagin Islands, on the south side of Korovin Island, approximately 1.5 miles northwest of Cape Devine, within protracted Sections 20 and 29, Township 55 South, Range 71 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska.

A protest must clearly state the nature and purpose of the protest in accordance with 11 AAC 64.450 and be submitted to both the applicant and the Department of Natural Resources by certified or registered mail no later than **January 30, 2020**.
