



**Strategic:**

- The location at the head of the Agulowak River, or at the mouth of Elva Creek, on Lake Nerka makes it a prime target for developers. This would impact not only the habitat along the river and lakeshore, but would increase fishing pressure on a world-class resource that is currently well managed for sustainability. It would impact the existing recreational experience for those in the area.
- This action is supported by the Southwest Alaska Conservation Coalition, a regional partnership of commercial, native, private, non-profit and government interests working cooperatively to secure native allotment in-holdings within parks and refuges for conservation purposes.

- Parcel already purchased by the Conservation Fund.
- Purchase agreement will be developed as soon as purchase by the Conservation Fund is complete.


