**City of Peltville, Alaska
Resolution # 17-08**

**Authorize the City to Submit to the State of Alaska
a Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant Application
to Assist with Improvements at Ermine Park**

WHEREAS the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation administers the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) grant program;

WHEREAS LWCF provides up to 50% matching funds for public outdoor recreation projects;

WHEREAS Ermine Park is a popular 10-acre area along the bluff of Peltville previously designated for public outdoor recreation use and is in need of upgrades;

WHEREAS the City is a qualified applicant for LWCF grant assistance, and Ermine Park has been identified in the City's Master Plan as a high priority for needed upgrades;

WHEREAS the City of Peltville proposes to use \$75,000 in LWCF grant funds to assist with upgrades in Ermine Park;

WHEREAS the City intends to use local funds, donations, and a Lions Club grant as match;

WHEREAS the City commits to maintaining Ermine Park in perpetuity for public outdoor recreation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Peltville supports preparation and submission of a Land and Water Conservation Fund grant application; further, the City Manager is authorized to negotiate, execute and administer all documents required for the application and acceptance of an LWCF grant, and to manage those funds on behalf of the City.

ENACTED this 22nd day of May 2017 by a vote of 6 in favor and 0 opposed.
